Dear US Forest Service,

I am deeply concerned about the Forest Service proposed thinning 21,000 acres of our National Forest, with additional prescribed burns on 43,000 acres. Past such projects have been very severe, with over 90% of trees removed and then new growth burned off regularly. The forest becomes ecologically broken.

Before a project of this scope is started PLEASE do a comprehensive environmental impact statement !!!

- 1) A comprehensive Environmental Impact Statement is required for a project of this scope and size that may have significant impacts on the human environment and on resources such as recreation, Roadless Areas, and Wildlife.
- 2) The Analysis must be site-specific. The condition-based approach is too general and vague to make meaningful scoping comments.
